Once you have finished reading your book of choice, you will be creating a project called a “One Pager”. A One Pager is a way to visually share key ideas and information from what you’ve learned from your story. When you create a one-pager you are trying to use both visual symbols plus important words to clearly and concisely share your most important takeaways of your book.

Here is a checklist regarding what your One-Pager MUST INCLUDE (inside the borders):

- ___ Your Name, the Title of the book, the name of the author
- ___ An image of the main character with their name
- ___ A list of 1-5 character traits or adjectives that describe the main character.
- ___ A drawing of the setting in the book.
- ___ One important quote that stood out to you with the page number. Then, include your reaction to this quote and why it stood out to you.
- ___ List the top five events of the book *in sequential order* in writing.
- ___ The theme (or main message) of the story. For example: “Don’t judge a book by its cover” is a message that is seen in many movies, books and t.v. shows.
- ___ Describe the Genre or type of book it is in 1-2 sentences.
- ___ Include any important images from the book that stood out to you in your reading.
